Ninth Annual Arts & Olive Festival Set for October 1 at Cañada College

This year's festival will feature a special designers' sale featuring textiles, artwork and home accessories. The sale is being organized by the Cañada College student chapter of the American Society of Interior Designers. All profits from the sale will be used to support the chapter's activities and the Dr. Genevieve Cory Scholarship Fund. The sale will be held in Building 13, Room 17.
