their own children and attend to their husband's.

Many of them accept, in silence, the ill treatment and exploitation they live in their own homes and this leads Latina women to develop an inability to express their emotions.

In her book, Emotional Nostalgia, Maria del Carmen Valdés gives a voice and a face to every woman in our

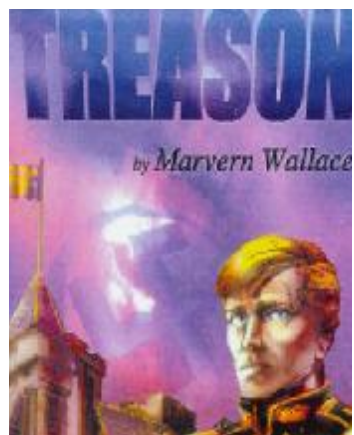
